



Ilan Stavans is Lewis-Sebring Professor in Latin American and Latino Culture and Five College 40th Anniversary Professor at Amherst College. His books include *The Hispanic Condition* (1995), *The Riddle of Cantinflas* (1997), *On Borrowed Words* (2001), *Spanglish* (2003), *Dictionary Days* (2005), and *The Disappearance* (2006). He is the editor of, among other work, *The Oxford Book of Latin American Essays* (1998), *The Poetry of Pablo Neruda* (2003), the 4-volume *Encyclopedia Latina* (2005), and *Lengua Fresca* (2006). He is the recipient of numerous awards and honors, including a Guggenheim Fellowship, the Latino Hall of Fame Award, Chile's Presidential Medal, the Rubén Darío Medal, and the National Jewish Book Award. Routledge published *The Essential Ilan Stavans* in 2000 and University of Wisconsin Press brought out *Ilan Stavans: Eight Conversations*, by Neal Sokol, in 2004. His oeuvre has been translated into a dozen languages.
